Annual General Meeting of PEGAS NONWOVENS SA resolved to make a dividend

LUXEMBOURG/ZNOJMO, 15 June 2017 – The Annual General Meeting of the shareholders of PEGAS NONWOVENS SA (hereafter “PEGAS” or “the Company”), held in Luxembourg on 15 June 2017, resolved to make a dividend payment in the amount of EUR 11,998,220, i.e. EUR 1.30 per share.
